Size: 28cm/11inch tall when made with the recommended yarn. If he is made with

"fingering" yarn, he will be about 10-15% smaller.

This crochet pattern is a **FREE** crochet pattern that I designed as a gift to all my fans and as a "thank you". Last year (2024) so many of you got my Bethlehem nativity set, Crafty Harlequin and my Gloriana Christmas Angel and I thought it would be nice to thank you for that with this free crochet pattern.

Even though it is a FREE crochet pattern, you still cannot just go claim it as your own or sell it or distribute it or post it online or post parts of it online or print it to share with everyone, ... all that is still not allowed even though it is a free crochet pattern. Please keep to the rules.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Yarn: DK yarn such as milk cotton or Catona Softfun yarn, in these colors:

• Blue: 450-480m/ 495-535yd

Dark blue: 40-70m/ 45-75yd

Light blue: 100-130m/ 110-145yd

Black: 20-40m/ 20-45yd

• White: 1 strand

• Pink: 40-70m/ 45-75yd

Crochet hook: 2.5mm hook

Other things you also need: stuffing, stitch markers, scissors, tapestry needle, dowel (or thick chopstick or whatever you usually use to make sure the head stays upright)

ABBREVIATIONS (Us terms):

· Ch: chain

Slst: slip stitch

• Sc: single crochet

Hdc: half double crochet

Dc: double crochet

• Inc: increase

Dec: decrease

MR: magic ring

BLO: back loops only

FLO: front loops only

• R: row

EXTRA INFO

- The color needed for the row is mentioned at the beginning of the row. Is nothing is mentioned, then use the same color as the previous row
- The ch1 (or 2) from ch1 and turn does not count as a stitch
- Always crochet in both loops UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE
- The **1, **2, ... at the end of some rows, tell you which pictures goes with that row

PATTERN:

Head:

R1: with blue: 6sc in a MR

R2: inc 6x

R3: [1sc, inc] repeat (18)

R4: [1sc, inc, 1sc] repeat (24)

R5: [3sc, inc] repeat (30)

R6: [2sc, inc, 2sc] repeat (36)

R7: [5sc, inc] repeat (42)

R8: [3sc, inc, 3sc] repeat (48)

R9: [7sc, inc] repeat (54)

R10: [4sc, inc, 4sc] repeat (60)

R11: [19sc, inc] repeat (63)

R12: 63sc

R13: [10sc, inc, 10sc] repeat (66)

R14-15: 66sc

R16: [21sc, inc] repeat (69)

R17-27: 69sc

R28: [21sc, dec] repeat (66)

R29: [10sc, dec, 10sc] repeat (63)

R30: [19sc, dec] repeat (60)

R31: with blue: 15sc, with light blue:

30sc, with blue: 15sc (60)

 From now on the color you use for your stitch must match the color of the stitch below = light blue in

light blue, blue in blue

R32: [9sc, dec, 9sc] repeat (57)

R33: [17sc, dec] repeat (54)

R34: [7sc, dec] repeat (48)

R35: [3sc, dec, 3sc] repeat (42)

R36: [5sc, dec] repeat (36)

R37: [2sc, dec, 2sc] repeat (30)

R38: [3sc, dec] repeat (24)

R39-40: 24sc

 From now on all rows are completely in blue. The light blue part will be added later

R41: [3sc, inc] repeat (30)

R42: [2sc, inc, 2sc] repeat (36)

R43: 36sc

R44: [11sc, inc] repeat (39)

R45: 39sc

R46: [6sc, inc, 6sc] repeat (42)

R47: 42sc

R48: [13sc, inc] repeat (45)

R49-50: 45sc

R51: [7sc, inc, 7sc] repeat (48)

R52-53: 48sc

R54: [15sc, inc] repeat (51)

R55-56: 51sc

R57: [8sc, inc, 8sc] repeat (54)

R58-59: 54sc

R60: [17sc, inc] repeat (57)

R61-62: 57sc

R63: [9sc, inc, 9sc] repeat (60)

R64-65: 60sc

R66: [19sc, inc] repeat (63)

R67-68: 63sc

R69: {19sc, dec] repeat (60)

R70: [4sc, dec, 4sc] repeat (54)

R71: [7sc, dec] repeat (48)

R72: [3sc, dec, 3sc] repeat (42)

R73: [5sc, dec] repeat (36)

R74: [2sc, dec, 2sc] repeat (30)

R75: [3sc, dec] repeat (24)

R76: [1sc, dec, 1sc] repeat (18)

Stuff now

 To avoid having the head fall, insert a dowel or thick chopstick into the head and body

R77: [1sc, dec] repeat (12)

R78: dec 6x (6)

Cut the yarn

Belly:

R1: with light blue: ch13

R2: start in the 2nd ch from the hook:

12sc, ch1, turn

R3: 12sc, ch1, turn

R4: inc, 10sc, inc, ch1, turn (14)

R5: 14sc, ch1, turn

R6: inc, 12sc, inc, ch1, turn (16)

R7-8: 16sc, ch1, turn

R9: inc, 14sc, inc, ch1, turn (18)

R10-20: 18sc, ch1, turn

R21: dec, 14sc, dec, ch1, turn (16)

R22: 16sc, ch1, turn

R23: dec, 12sc, dec, ch1, turn (14)

R24: 14sc, ch1, turn

R25: dec, 10sc, dec, ch1, turn (12)

R26: dec, 8sc, dec, ch1, turn (10)

R27: dec, 6sc, dec, ch1, turn (8)

R28: dec, 4sc, dec, ch1, turn (6)

 Cut the yarn and reattach to stitch 1 of R1

• Make sc all around in all 4 sides

Cut the yarn but leave a tail

• Sew in place on the belly (*1)



Versluys righted

Legs:

R1: with dark blue: 6sc in a MR

R2: inc 6x (12)

R3: [1sc, inc] repeat (18)

R4: [1sc, inc, 1sc] repeat (24)

R5: with blue: [3sc, inc] repeat (30)

R6: [2sc, inc, 2sc] repeat (36)

R7: [5sc, inc] repeat (42)

R8:

Step 1: FLO: with blue: 13sc,

 Step 2: FLO: skip 1 stitch, then with dark blue make 6dc in the next stitch, then make 1slst in the next stitch,

Step 3: FLO: with blue: 1sc,

Step 4: FLO: repeat step 2-3 another
 3x,

• Step 5: with blue: 13sc

R9: 42sc... when you get to the stitches behind those of step 2-4 of R8, you will

need to crochet <u>behind the dark blue part</u>, in the back loops of R7

R10-12: 42sc

R13: 9sc, then 3x [3sc, dec, 3sc], then 9sc

(39)

R14: [11sc, dec] repeat (36)

R15: 9sc, then 3x [2sc, dec, 2sc], then 9sc

(33)

R16: [9sc, dec] repeat (30)

R17-20: 30sc

R21: [9sc, inc] repeat (33)

R22-23: 33sc

R24: [5sc, inc, 5sc] repeat (36)

R25-26: 36sc

• 1slst in the 1st stitch

• Cut the yarn but leave a tail

Stuff the leg

Make the 2nd leg the same way

stuffing if necessary (*2-3)

• Sew them both in place and add more





Arms (2x):

R1: with dark blue: 6sc in a MR

R2: inc 6x (12)

R3: with blue: [1sc, inc] repeat (18)

R4: [1sc, inc, 1sc] repeat (24)

R5: [3sc, inc] repeat (30)

R6: FLO: 9sc, then:

Step 1: skip 1 stitch,

 Step 2: FLO: with dark blue: in the next stitch make 4dc, then make 1slst in the same stitch as the one you just made those dc in

 Step 3: FLO: with blue: 1sc in the next stitch

Repeat step 1-3 another 3x, then with
 blue: make 1sc in each of the
 remaining stitches of R5

R7: with blue: 30sc ... when you get to the stitches behind those of step 1-3 of R6, you will need to crochet behind the dark blue stitches of step 2-3 of R6 and in the

BL of R5

R8-9: 30sc

R10: 7sc, then 4x [1sc, dec, 1sc], then 7sc

(26)

R11: 26sc

R12: 11sc, dec, 11sc, dec (24)

R13: [3sc, dec, 3sc] repeat (21)

R14-23: 21sc

R24: [5sc, dec] repeat (18)

R25: [1sc, dec] repeat (12)

- Stuff now as normal except for the top (the shoulder). You want the shoulder stuffed only lightly
- Cut the yarn but leave a tail
- Make the 2nd arm the same way
- Sew them in place (*4-5)

R26: dec 6x (6)





Eyes (2x):

R1: with black: 6sc in a MR

R2: inc 6x (12)

R3: 3sc, then inc 6x, then 3sc (18)

R4: 6sc, then inc 6x, then 6sc (24)

R5: 9sc, then inc 6x, then 9sc (30)

R6: with light blue: BLO: 12sc, then inc 6x, then 12sc (36)

R7-8: 36sc

- 1slst in the 1st stitch
- Cut the yarn but leave a tail
- Make a 2nd eye the same way
- Flatten the eyes and if your yarn allows it, you can even iron them flat
- Pin the eyes in place and then sew in place (*6)
- Sew some white spots on the eyes with white yarn (*7)

Sew with light blue yarn along the top of the light blue part of the face (*8)



Nose:

R1: with dark blue: 6sc in a MR

R2: inc 6x (12)

R3: [1sc, inc] repeat (18)

R4: [1sc, inc, 1sc] repeat (24)

R5-6: 24sc

R7: **BLO**: [1sc, dec, 1sc] repeat (18)

R8: [1sc, dec] repeat (12)

Stuff lightly

R9: dec 6x (6)

Cut the yarn

Sew the nose in place with the FLO of R6 (*9)



Ears (2x):

Part 1:

R1: with pink: ch20

 You will need to crochet around the chain now. Watch this tutorial on my Craftygenesindonesia YouTube channel about this: https://youtu.be/s5NcBYBqZ0M?si=jJApY-e4_4DIKuXE

R2: start in the 2nd ch from the hook: 18sc, 3sc in the last ch, then on the other side: 18sc, ch1, turn (39)

You need to crochet back and forth now, not in continuous rows

R3: 18sc, inc 3x, 18sc, ch1, turn (42)

R4: 18sc, inc, 1sc, **hdc inc** 2x, 1sc, inc, 18sc, ch1, turn (46)

R5: 18sc, inc, 2sc, 1hdc, hdc inc 2x, 1hdc, 2sc, inc, 18sc, ch1, turn (50)

R6: 10sc, 8hdc, hdc inc, 5hdc, hdc inc 2x, 5hdc, hdc inc, 8hdc, 10sc, ch1, turn (54)

R7: 8sc, 10hdc, hdc inc, 7hdc, hdc inc 2x, 7hdc, hdc inc, 10hdc, 8sc (58)

- Cut the yarn
- Make 2 ears like this


Part 2:


- Make these ears the same way as the part 1 ears but this time with blue and do not cut the yarn when down with the blue one
- Instead, you place a pink ear on the blue ear and crochet them together the following way (*10-11):

R8: with blue: 19sc, then 4x [2sc, inc, 2sc], then 19sc (62) (*10)

- Cut the yarn but leave a tail
- Do the same with the 2nd blue + pink ear

• Sew them in place (*12-16)







At the end you want to sew the ears in a more upright position. That is what I am showing here in *15-16
